Enrolment

P1 enrolment Children who are age 5 between 1 March 2025 and the end of February 2026 are required to register their child for starting school in August 2025 by completing an online registration form which will be available from **Monday 6 January 2025**. If your

child falls into this category or you know of anyone who has children this age, please make a note of this date. Please do not enrol before this date as it won't be processed, and you would then be required to enrol again from 8th January. The registration form is available on the SLC website <u>Enrolling your child for school - South</u> <u>Lanarkshire Council</u>. The school will then contact the family between Monday 13 and Friday 17 January to discuss the enrolment submitted.

Adverse Weather If it is snowing in the morning and the ground is covered our janitor, will make every effort to ensure a path is available to the door nearest the main school gate. Whilst it is rare for the school to be closed due to adverse weather, in the event of an ELC or School closure or delayed start, Parents Portal (School) and Learning Journals (ELC) will be our first and main method of communicating updates to families.
